

#### 23/203 Report from County Councillor

County Council Youth Service have recently commenced some outreach work in the village. We are looking to bring back the mobile youth bus.

It has been recently confirmed with Stagecoach that the Sherwood Arrow evening bus service is being restarted. The service has restarted from the 7<sup>th</sup> April, meaning bus services from Nottingham to Ollerton will depart the city at 9.20pm and 11.20pm to Worksop.

Recently there has been a cross-party (Labour/Independent/Conservative) scrutiny review of the Household Waste Recycling Centres in the county with an intention to invest in better and more easily accessible HWRC's, which have less impact on the quality of life of local residents that live nearby to HWRC sites. Some sites struggle with demand and have no capacity to grow, and in turn some sites cause traffic issues. To this end a cross-party review to assess the current locations, accessibility, use of existing sites. No final decisions have yet been made on scrutiny's recommendations, as they have not yet been presented to Cabinet.
